

Performing Arts Scholarship

Performing Arts Scholarship applicants are required to:

- Register for, and sit the Edutest Scholarship test on Saturday 20 February 2021 (registration link available from the College website)
- Submit the Supplementary Information Form (available from the College website)
- Attend an audition at the College

Auditions will be held prior to the Scholarship test in the period 15 February – 18 February. Applicants will be provided with their audition time in the week prior to the audition. Applicants must be available to attend the audition as scheduled.

At the audition applicants will be required to present a monologue, dance routine or vocal/instrumental performance.

Students must have strong skills in the Performing Arts and a desire to lead and inspire others in this area. Students will be asked questions about the kinds of performances and groups they belong to in the Performing Arts.

A performance can be

- 1 minute memorised monologue of the student's choosing
- Instrumental performance
- Vocal performance with instrumental or pre-recorded backing track
- 1 minute dance routine (preferably choreographed by the student, but not a requirement)

Supporting music can be played by an accompanist or prerecorded on a phone, CD or MP3. Backing tracks for singers must be instrumental only.
