

Visual Arts Scholarship

Visual Arts Scholarship applicants are required to:

- Register for, and sit the Edutest Scholarship test on Saturday 20 February 2021 (registration link available from the College website)
- Submit the Supplementary Information Form (available from the College website)
- Attend an interview at the College

Interviews will be held prior to the Scholarship test in the period 15 February – 18 February. Applicants will be provided with their interview time in the week prior to the audition. Applicants must be available to attend the interview as scheduled.

At the interview applicants will be required to present and discuss a folio of their work.

Students must have strong skills in the Visual Arts and a desire to lead and inspire others in this area. Students will be asked questions about the kinds of artistic projects they have been involved in and their preferred styles and artistic mediums.

A folio of work can include:

- Art created during Junior/Primary school years
- Drawing, painting and sculptural artwork produced at home
- Sketchbooks of student illustrations
- Photographs of student's artwork
- Other creative visual solutions
